This meeting (webinar) builds upon the discussions and identified next steps from the first Project Team meeting on May 22, 2019 ([here](#) for Meeting #1 agenda). Among other discussions of process and timeline for FMP development, the Project Team engaged in a brainstorm to identify priorities for a de minimis fishery as well as available data streams and needed information.
