

Upcoming July 21-22 PSU Collection Event

Following the vote to alternate PSU gathering between Sonoma and Mendocino Counties, the next all-volunteer collection will be held July 21-22 at Albion/Schooner Landing.

Every diver will need a fishing license.

If you have one or more of these items, please bring them:

- 1) Boat—the bigger, the better (Schooners Landing is offering dock space for this event)
- 2) Collection bags (Seals Watersports in Santa Rosa sells a canvas bag with a mesh bottom for \$15 that is perfect for this effort)
- 3) SCUBA tanks
- 4) Float lines
- 5) Safety sausage or small floats
- 6) Kayak
- 7) 5 gallon bucket
- 8) Three prong garden claw

On-shore help is also needed and greatly appreciated.

Expect a briefing on site at 8 AM. This will entail what is legal and what is not. Each diver's daily limit is 20 gallons, which may be interpreted as 20 gallons of crushed PSUs. (Note: this limit applies only to Sonoma and Mendocino Counties and sunsets Nov. 6, 2018.) At this point, DFW is fine with us crushing the urchins in the water so long as we are using them for something, e.g., attracting fish for spearfishing or photography, but they must be counted as part of the diver's limit.
